Axis Bank Ties Up With Ahli United Bank B.S.C., Bahrain for Inward Remittances to India

Mumbai, May 28, 2012: Axis Bank, India's third largest private Bank, today announced its tie up with Ahli United Bank B.S.C., Bahrain for remitting money from Bahrain to any person in India.

After its successful tie up with various correspondent banks in the Middle East, Axis Bank has now entered into an agreement with Ahli United Bank B.S.C., Bahrain for offering remittance facilities to India. This will provide wider options to NRIs in Bahrain for sending money to India. Any person in Bahrain who is a customer of Ahli United Bank B.S.C., can use this service for money transfer to India from the internet banking platform of Ahli United Bank B.S.C. known as MyE-Bank.

Such remittances would be processed seamlessly and disbursed to the intended beneficiaries holding an account with Axis Bank or any of more than 83,000 NEFT-enabled branches of over 100 other banks in India. Under this arrangement, there is no limit on the number of transactions that can be initiated. Presently, customers can initiate transactions upto BHD 5,000 per day. While transactions pertaining to Axis Bank accounts would be credited instantly, the ones pertaining to Non Axis Bank accounts would be processed on real time basis and the final credit to beneficiary accounts shall take 1 to 2 working days depending on the respective beneficiary banks.

This is our first banking tie up in the Kingdom of Bahrain and will help us to specifically cater to the NRIs based in Bahrain.
